The National Energy Commission issues a Regulation for processing of Provisional Concessions for generation projects from renewable sources of energy.

As of January 11, 2019, by resolution "CNE-AD-001-2019", the National Energy Commission (CNE) ordered the entry into force of a new regulation, which establishes the requirements for processing applications for provisional concessions in power generation projects, with the use of natural resources, in addition to the provisions in the current regulations that rules the energy and electrical sector of the Dominican Republic.

Among its provisions, said regulation requires all petitioners to comply with new formal and substantive requirements in order to obtain the approval of a concession; as well as the technical, legal and economic criteria that will serve as parameters for the evaluation of requests for these concessions by the CNE. An upcoming resolution is pending, referring to the enabled areas for wind and photovoltaic projects.

Finally, it is important to highlight the value of this resolution within the energy sector, because it provides the lifting of the existing moratorium since 2015, regarding the receipt of applications for provisional concessions, related to the generation of electricity from renewable primary sources; this may represent an opening of the market to new generation projects.
